Welcome, Volunteers and Thank You!

- **Your time commitment and willingness to work are very important to the construction of this house.**
- **Schedules for construction projects are very fluid and depend on many factors, such as weather. (The website is updated daily with the latest information.)**
- **If you want to volunteer a specific skill, check the online schedule.**
- **We will try to use everyone to the best of their abilities, but sometimes your available time does not coincide with your best skill or your primary area of interest.**
- **Even if you have little or no construction experience, we will help train you.**
- **The website will inform volunteers of the work to be done the next week.**

Liability Waiver: On the first day on-site, **ALL VOLUNTEERS** must sign a liability waiver form **if you haven't signed up online with Habitat**. This is a mandatory legal requirement for Habitat for Humanity.

WEAR: Boots or shoes with sturdy soles (no sandals), a hat, and sunscreen.

MINIMUM AGE: 18 years (14 -17 year-old volunteers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian) and can not work on the site when power equipment (saws, etc.) are being used. This is an insurance mandate for Dayton Ohio Habitat for Humanity.

BRING: Basic hand tools, hammer, nail apron, tape measure, pencil, work gloves.

HOURS: Tuesday – Friday 8:00 am until 4:00 pm, Thursday, 5:30 pm – dark, & Saturday 8 am to 4:00 pm
