

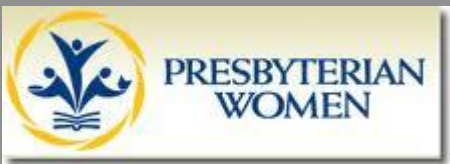
WESTMINSTER PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN

Some of the WPW Activities:

- **Circles: Fellowship groups.** Some are organized around an interest (reading or a mission activity) or sewing for others. Meeting times and frequency vary. All would welcome you.
- **Cookie Walk: A Christmas fundraiser** for designated missions we support.
- **Samaritan Homeless Clinic: We provide** cooking lessons, basic kitchen supplies, and an electric skillet when people are newly housed.
- **Project Blessing: We, along with other** churches, provide free lunches several times a year to those in need.
- **Memorial Receptions: A ministry to provide** receptions after funerals or memorial services for grieving families and friends.
- **Sewing Circle: A ministry to provide baby** clothes, knit caps and mittens, lap robes, turbans for cancer patients, and many other handmade items.
