One of the ways you might do so is through your commitment to support the work of Westminster Presbyterian Women (WPW) through dedicated giving. Not only do we nurture faith through prayer and study, but we also support the mission of the church worldwide, work for justice and peace, and seek to build an inclusive, caring community.

Severe weather the world over has had catastrophic effects on millions of people. And continued unrest in many places has displaced or harmed untold numbers of families. We can't address all of the world's needs, but we can make a difference. With your help, we can support charities desperately in need of funding so that they might more effectively minister to those who are in the greatest need of light and hope.

In 2024, WPW donated \$5,125 to local charitable organizations and \$11,672 to global missions (direct support \$4,672/PCUSA World Mission Fund \$7,000) supported through dedicated giving and our pecan sales mission fund raiser. If you contributed monies to our 2024 annual call, bought pecans, or sponsored school kits, THANK YOU! Additionally, WPW physically supported Westminster Presbyterian Church (10 memorial receptions) as well as those in need beyond its walls (150 school kits delivered to Church World Service). And this year, we are taking on yet another hands-on mission project, this time in support of Period Justice within our local community. 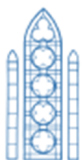

Westminster Presbyterian Women Mission Projects

Growing in faith as part of a faith community is integral to the life of Presbyterian Women and the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). In addition to Presbyterian worship and PW participation, we have a long history of nurturing our faith and doing our part to bring about peace, justice, and world-wide reconciliation by setting aside a portion of the gifts we've received to make this a reality for all.

And while none of us can do all that needs to be done, each of us can do our part. One of the ways we can do that is through mission support. As such, I ask you to prayerfully consider making a charitable donation to any or all of the PW-sponsored mission opportunities listed below:

My Gift: \$ _____ WPW Kids Kit (previously School Kit) Mission Project. We purchase, build, and package school kits (150 in 2022) and then forward them to Church World Services. These kits provide children in disaster areas, impoverished communities, and refugee camps the basic tools for learning. Although valued at \$15, plus a \$2 processing fee, because we purchase supplies during back-to-school sales, we are able to build and cover the processing fee for \$10 per kit. Donate and/or sponsor kits.

My Gift: \$ _____ WPW Period Justice Mission Project. We provide free period products to the 2 schools WPC supports, Dayton's YWCA/Domestic Violence Shelter, the Castle, and WPC (in support of the staff and congregation as well as visitors—worship, weddings, memorial services/receptions, tutoring, ID Ministry, gatherings, meetings, etc.). Donate pads and/or tampons, or monies to buy them.

My Gift: \$ _____ WPW Annual Dedicated Giving. Contributions fund local, national, and global mission project grants.

My Gift: \$ _____ PW Birthday Offering. Since 1922, Presbyterian Women have contributed more than \$36 Million to help improve lives at home and around the world.

My Gift: \$ _____ PW Thank Offering. Since 1988, Presbyterian Women have granted more than \$26 Million to nearly 1,700 different projects worldwide.

My Gift: \$ _____ PW Support to Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC). FLC is a global, ecumenical prayer movement that was begun in 1956 by Shanti Solomon of India. Her vision-now a reality-is that connectedness would arise from women praying for peace and reconciliation and setting aside the least coin of their country as a symbol of that prayer. FLC's international committee uses these monies to fund service and relief projects, worldwide.
